

Mrs Williams, Headmistress of Bishopston Comprehensive School, expressed the concern of the school and its Governing Body at the flouting of school rules by a group of school-children who absented themselves without permission at various times of the school day to visit and purchase from local shops. Appeals to local shopkeepers to report such truants had been generally forthcoming but with one exception. Mrs Williams detailed the steps that were to be taken against pupils who continued to disregard school rules which forbade the leaving of the school premises unless permission had been sought and granted. She now proposed to write to all parents highlighting the seriousness of this problem and asked if the Community Council could support the school with an appropriate insertion in the Council Newsletter.
